PROGRAM FOR KIDS CATEGORY 30 AUGUST

BORN BETWEEN 2010 & 2017 – KART LR6 200cc

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of free practice and then 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 32 drivers will be divided into 4 groups of 8 as follow:

Group A – from 1st to 8th

Group B – from 9th to 16th

Group C – from 17th to 24th

Group D – from 25th to 32nd

All the races have a rolling start and a kart change in the middle of each race.

Drivers weight – 60 kg

Starting from group D there will be 11 minutes of race 1 and 11 minutes of race 2. Same thing will be repeated with all groups. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 48 points to the last in group F.

Once the first two races have finished for everyone, the best time of race 1 and the best time of race 2 will be added together and the groups will be redone like before. Another two 11 minutes races will then take place, and points will be again awarded like in race 1 and 2.

Based on the score assigned, 4 groups of 8 drivers will be created and all are going to race in the superfinal with 5 minutes of qualifications and 16 minutes of race. Starting from the Superfinal D, then group C, B and A.

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST KIDS CATEGORY will be established by the sum of the points from the 5 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.

PROGRAM FOR JUNIOR CATEGORY – 31 AUGUST

BORN BETWEEN 2010 AND 2014, MINIMUM HEIGHT CM 145 – MINIMUM WEIGHT 47.5 KG (45 + SEAT INSERT) – KART RT10 270cc

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of free practice and then 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 40 drivers will be divided into 4 groups of 10 as follow:

Group A – from 1st° to 12th

Group B – from 13th to 24th

Group C – from 25th to 36th

All the races have a rolling start and a kart change in the middle of each race.

Drivers weight – 75 kg

Starting from group C there will be 11 minutes of race 1 and 11 minutes of race 2. Same thing will be repeated with all groups. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 36 points to the last in group C.

Once the first two races have finished for everyone, the best time of race 1 and the best time of race 2 will be added together and the groups will be redone like before. Another two 11 minutes races will then take place, and points will be again awarded like in race 1 and 2.

Based on the score assigned, 4 groups of 10 drivers will be created and all are going to race the superfinal with 5 minutes of qualification and 16 minutes of race. Starting from the Superfinal C, then group B and A.

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST JUNIOR CATEGORY will be established by the sum of the points from the 5 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.

PROGRAM FOR SPRINT CATEGORY – 31 AUGUST

BORN FROM YEAR 2010 – KART RT10 270cc

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of free practice and then 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 24 drivers will be divided into 2 groups of 12 as follow:

Group A – from 1st° to 12th

Group B – from 13th to 24th

All the races have a rolling start and a kart change in the middle of each race.

Drivers weight – 85 kg

Starting from group B there will be 11 minutes of race 1, 11 minutes of race 2 and 11 minutes of race 3. Same thing will be repeated with group A. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 24

points to the last in group B.

Once the first wave of races are finished for everyone, we are going to sum the best time of race 1 – 2 and 3 and reform the groups for the Superfinal (5 minutes of qualification + 16 minutes of race)

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST SPRINT CATEGORY will be established by the sum of the points from the 4 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.
