PROGRAM FOR KIDS CATEGORY 29 AUGUST

BORN BETWEEN 2011 & 2019 – KART LR6 200cc

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of free practice and then 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 44 drivers will be divided into 4 groups of 11 as follow:

Group A – from 1st to 11th

Group B – from 12th to 22nd

Group C – from 23th to 33th

Group D – from 34th to 44TH

All the races have a rolling start and a kart change at the end of each race.

Drivers weight – 60 kg

Starting from group D there will be 10 minutes of race 1 and 10 minutes of race 2. Same thing will be repeated with all groups. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 44 points to the last in group D.

Once the first two races have finished for everyone, the best time of race 1 and the best time of race 2 will be added together and the groups will be redone like before. Another two 10 minutes races will then take place, and points will be again awarded like in race 1 and 2.

Based on the score assigned, 4 groups of 11 drivers will be created and all are going to race in the superfinal with 5 minutes of qualifications and 15 minutes of race. Starting from the Superfinal D, then group C, B and A.

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST KIDS CATEGORY will be established by the sum of the points from the 5 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.

PROGRAM FOR JUNIOR CATEGORY – 30 AUGUST

BORN BETWEEN 2009 AND 2015, MINIMUM HEIGHT CM 145 – MINIMUM WEIGHT 45 KG (42.5 + SEAT INSERT) – KART RT10 270cc

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of free practice and then 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 39 drivers will be divided into 3 groups of 13 as follow:

Group A – from 1st° to 13th

Group B – from 14th to 26th

Group C – from 27th to 39th

All the races have a rolling start and a kart change at the end of each race.

Drivers weight – 75 kg

Starting from group C there will be 10 minutes of race 1 and 10 minutes of race 2. Same thing will be repeated with all groups. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 39 points to the last in group C.

Once the first two races have finished for everyone, the best time of race 1 and the best time of race 2 will be added together and the groups will be redone like before. Another two 10 minutes races will then take place, and points will be again awarded like in race 1 and 2.

Based on the score assigned, 3 groups of 13 drivers will be created and all are going to race the superfinal with 5 minutes of qualification and 15 minutes of race. Starting from the Superfinal C, then group B and A.

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST JUNIOR CATEGORY will be established by the sum of the points from the 5 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.
