

# AFFI KART SUMMER FEST 2024

## KIDS CATEGORY – BORN BETWEEN 2009 & 2015 – KART LR6 200cc

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 48 drivers will be divided into 6 groups of 8 as follow:

Group A – from 1st to 8th

Group B – from 9th to 16th

Group C – from 17th to 24th

Group D – from 25th to 32nd

Group E – from 33rd to 40th

Group F – from 41st to 48th

Starting from group F there will be 11 minutes of race 1 and 11 minutes of race 2. Same thing will be repeated with all groups. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 48 points to the last in group F.

Once the first two races have finished for everyone, the best time of race 1 and the best time of race 2 will be added together and the groups will be redone like before. Another two 11 minutes races will then take place, and points will be again awarded like race 1 and 2.

**All the races have a rolling start and a kart change in the middle of each race.**

Based on the score assigned, 6 groups of 8 drivers will be created and all are going to race in the superfinal with 5 minutes of qualifications and 16 minutes of race. Starting from the Superfinal F, then group E, D, C, B and A.

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

**The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST KIDS CATEGORY will be established by the sum of the points of the 5 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.**

**In the event of a new tie, the fastest time of the superfinal are checked.**

- Driver weight for the years 2009-2012 - Kg 60 checked at the end of each race.
- Driver weight for the years 2013-2015 - Kg 50 checked at the end of each race.

**JUNIOR CATEGORY – BORN BETWEEN 2009 AND 2013, MINIMUM HEIGHT CM 145 – MINIMUM WEIGHT 50 KG – KART RT10 270cc**

All the drivers start with 10 minutes of qualifications. Once the qualifications are over, a general ranking will be made and the 48 drivers will be divided into 4 groups of 10 as follow:

Group A – from 1st<sup>o</sup> to 10th

Group B – from 11th to 20th

Group C – from 21st to 30th

Group D – from 31st to 40th

Starting from group D there will be 11 minutes of race 1 and 11 minutes of race 2. Same thing will be repeated with all groups. We will award 1 point to the 1st of the group A up to 40 points to the last in group D.

Once the first two races have finished for everyone, the best time of race 1 and the best time of race 2 will be added together and the groups will be redone like before. Another two 11 minutes races will then take place, and points will be again awarded like race 1 and 2.

**All the races have a rolling start and karti change in the middle of each race.**

Based on the score assigned, 4 groups of 10 drivers will be created and all are going to race the superfinal with 5 minutes of qualification and 16 minutes of race. Starting from the Superfinal D, then group C, B and A.

The point assigned for the superfinal are 1 for the 1st, 3 for the 2nd, 5 for the 3rd and so on.

**The winner of the AFFI KART SUMMER FEST JUNIOR CATEGORY will be established by sum of the points of the 5 races. In the event of a tie, the number of victories will be counted.**

**In the event of a new tie, the fastest time of the superfinal are checked.**

Driver weight Kg 75 checked at the end of each race.

**In both Kids and Junior categories, 3 results will be calculated for the SWS championship: the first based on the sum of points of the first two races, the second based on the sum of points of races 3 and 4 and the last one based on the outcome of the superfinal.**
